5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 41.413, Tax Code, is amended by amending

7 Subsection (d) and adding Subsections (e), (f), and (g) to read as

follows: 8

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- A [The] property owner shall [timely] send to a [the] 9
- person leasing [the] property under a contract described by this 10

section a copy of any notice of appraised value of the property [the 11

12 property's reappraisal] received by the property owner.

property owner must send the notice not later than the 10th day

14 after the date the property owner receives the notice. Failure of

the property owner to send a copy of the notice to the person 15

16 leasing the property does not affect the time within which the

person leasing the property may protest the appraised value. This

subsection does not apply if the property owner and the person 18

leasing the property have agreed in the contract to waive the 19

requirements of this subsection or that the person leasing the 20

21 property will not protest the appraised value of the property.

22 (e) A person leasing property under a contract described by

23 this section may request that the chief appraiser of the appraisal

district in which the property is located send the notice described 24

- 1 by Subsection (d) to the person. Except as provided by Subsection
- 2 (f), the chief appraiser shall send the notice to the person leasing
- 3 the property not later than the fifth day after the date the notice
- 4 is sent to the property owner if the person demonstrates that the
- 5 person is contractually obligated to reimburse the property owner
- 6 for the taxes imposed on the property.
- 7 <u>(f) A chief appraiser who receives a request under</u>
- 8 Subsection (e) is not required to send the notice requested under
- 9 that subsection if the appraisal district in which the property
- 10 that is the subject of the notice is located posts the appraised
- 11 value of the property on the district's Internet website not later
- 12 than the fifth day after the date the notice is sent to the property
- 13 owner.
- 14 (g) A person leasing property under a contract described by
- 15 this section may designate another person to act as the agent of the
- 16 lessee for any purpose under this title. The lessee must make the
- 17 designation in the manner provided by Section 1.111. An agent
- 18 designated under this subsection has the same authority and is
- 19 subject to the same limitations as an agent designated by a property
- 20 owner under Section 1.111.
- 21 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a notice of appraised value sent to a property owner on or after the
- 23 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
