- 6 SECTION 1. Section 75.007(e), Civil Practice and Remedies
- 7 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (e) This section does not affect Section 75.001, 75.002,
- 9 $\left[\frac{75.0021}{7}\right]$ 75.003, or 75.004 or create or increase the liability of
- 10 any person.
- SECTION 2. Sections 75.0021 and 75.0022(b), Civil Practice
- 12 and Remedies Code, are repealed.
- SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 15 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 16 of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the cause of action
- 17 immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect
- 18 for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
