(f) <u>The</u> [<u>If the</u>] envelope <u>must</u> [<u>does not</u>] bear the cancellation mark or receipt mark as required by Subsection (<u>e)(2)</u> [<u>(e)(3), a delivery under Subsection (d)(1) is presumed</u>] to be timely [<u>if the other requirements</u>] under this section [<u>are met</u>]. [<u>Section 1.006 does not apply to Subsection (d)(3).</u>]

23 SECTION 2. Section 87.125(a-1), Election Code, is amended 24 to read as follows:

(a-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for an election held
on the date of the general election for state and county officers,
the early voting ballot board shall convene to count ballots voted

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1 by mail described by <u>Sections</u> [Section] 86.007(d) and (d-1) not 2 later than the 13th day after the date of the election.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
