4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 38.004, Education Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (c), (d), and (e) to
7	read as follows:
8	(b) Each school district shall provide child abuse
9	antivictimization programs in elementary and secondary schools.
10	The programs must include annual age-appropriate, research-based
11	child sexual abuse prevention training designed to promote
12	self-protection and prevent sexual abuse and trafficking of
13	children. The district shall:
14	(1) choose the provider and the method of delivery of
15	the training;
16	(2) each year include a description of the training:
17	(A) in an informational handbook provided to
18	students, parents, and guardians; or
19	(B) on the Internet website of the school
20	district, if the district does not provide an informational
21	handbook to students, parents, and guardians;
22	(3) ensure that each student enrolled in the district
23	attends the training each year; and
24	(4) provide at least two opportunities each year for a

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1 student to attend the training required that year. 2 (c) Not later than September 1 of each year, each school 3 district shall submit to the agency a report on the number and percentage of students enrolled in the district who attended the 4 5 child sexual abuse prevention training required by Subsection (b) during the preceding school year. 6 7 (d) The agency shall compile a list of objectives that must 8 be met by a school district's child sexual abuse prevention training required under Subsection (b). 9 10 (e) This section and Section 38.0041 may be cited as Jenna's Law. 11 SECTION 2. It is not the intent of the legislature that the 12 changes in law made by this Act be interpreted as requiring the 13 14 provision of human sexuality instruction. 15 SECTION 3. A school district shall submit the initial report required by Section 38.004(c), Education Code, as added by 16 17 this Act, not later than September 1, 2018. SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 18 school year. 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
