11	written report of the investigation and submit the report and its
12	recommendations to the [district attorney and, if a law enforcement
13	agency has not investigated the report of abuse, neglect,
14	exploitation, or other complaint, to the] appropriate law
15	enforcement agency.
16	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
17	an investigation completed on or after the effective date of this
18	Act.
19	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
