- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 29.923 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 29.923. WORKPLACE SAFETY TRAINING INFORMATION. (a)
- 8 The agency shall collect and make available to a school district on
- 9 request information regarding workplace safety training that may be
- 10 included as part of the district's curriculum.
- 11 (b) A school district may develop a workplace safety program
- 12 that provides educators access to the information described by
- 13 <u>Subsection (a) and encourages educators to include the workplace</u>
- 14 safety training information in the curriculum of appropriate
- 15 courses provided to students enrolled in grades 7 through 12.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 17 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
