- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 531.02171 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 531.02171. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN TELEHEALTH
- 8 SERVICES. (a) In this section, "health professional" has the
- 9 meaning assigned by Section 531.0217.
- 10 (b) The commission shall ensure that Medicaid reimbursement
- 11 is provided to a school district or open-enrollment charter school
- 12 for telehealth services provided through the school district or
- 13 charter school by a health professional, even if the health
- 14 professional is not the patient's primary care physician or
- 15 provider, if:
- 16 (1) the school district or charter school is an
- 17 <u>authorized health care provider under Medicaid;</u>
- 18 (2) the parent or legal guardian of the patient
- 19 provides consent before the service is provided; and
- 20 (3) another health professional is present with the
- 21 patient during the provision of the service.
- 22 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 23 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 24 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

- 1 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 2 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 3 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
