1 AN ACT 2 relating to the board of trustees of the Weatherford Junior College 3 District. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 130.0828 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 130.0828. ADDITIONAL TRUSTEES FOR WEATHERFORD JUNIOR 7 COLLEGE DISTRICT. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, in addition 8 9 to the members of the board of trustees of the Weatherford Junior College District elected or appointed under other provisions of 10 this subchapter, the commissioners court of each county in which a 11 12 branch campus of the district is located and that imposed a branch campus maintenance tax under Section 130.253 on September 1, 2017, 13 14 shall appoint one member to serve on the district's board of 15 trustees. 16 (b) Members of the board of trustees appointed under this section serve two-year terms and may be appointed to serve 17 successive terms. The commissioners court shall appoint initial 18 19 members to serve a term beginning December 1, 2017. (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a member of the 20 board of trustees appointed under this section may participate in 21 the decision-making of the board to the same extent as any other 22 23 member of the board, including by voting on any budget that affects

the entire district.

- 1 (d) A member of the board of trustees appointed under this
- 2 section:
- 3 (1) may not participate in the decision-making of the
- 4 board in matters related to:
- 5 (A) the imposition of a tax; or
- 6 (B) an issue that only affects a campus located
- 7 <u>in the junior college district;</u>
- 8 (2) is not counted for purposes of determining whether
- 9 a quorum of the board is present for the purpose of Subdivision (1);
- 10 <u>and</u>
- 11 (3) may not serve as an officer of the board of
- 12 trustees.
- (e) Unless this section is continued in effect by the
- 14 legislature, this section expires on December 1, 2027.
- 15 SECTION 2. The commissioners court of each county to which
- 16 Section 130.0828, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies
- 17 shall appoint the initial members of the board of trustees of the
- 18 Weatherford Junior College District under that section not later
- 19 than November 30, 2017.
- 20 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. (a) It is the intent of the
- 21 legislature that every provision, section, subsection, sentence,
- 22 clause, phrase, and word in this Act, and every application of the
- 23 provisions in this Act to each local law, are severable from each
- 24 other. All constitutionally valid and lawful applications of this
- 25 Act shall be severed from an application that a court finds to be
- 26 invalid, leaving the valid applications in force because it is the
- 27 legislature's intent and priority that the valid applications be

- 1 allowed to stand alone.
- 2 (b) A court may not decline to enforce the severability
- 3 requirements in this Act on the ground that the enforcement of the
- 4 severability requirements would be contrary to legislative intent.
- 5 The legislature hereby declares that it intends for the
- 6 severability requirements of this Act to be enforced as written,
- 7 without any exceptions.
- 8 (c) A court may not decline to enforce the severability
- 9 requirements of this Act on the ground that the Act's provisions or
- 10 applications are essentially and inseparably connected. The
- 11 legislature hereby declares that it intends for the severability
- 12 requirements of this Act to be enforced without regard to whether
- 13 this Act's provisions or applications are essentially and
- 14 inseparably connected.
- 15 (d) If a final court order or judgment finds that the
- 16 composition of the board of trustees of the Weatherford Junior
- 17 College District as composed under this Act is invalid, the
- 18 court-ordered remedy shall require the appointment of members of
- 19 the board of trustees by the commissioners court of each county in
- 20 which a branch campus of the district is located in the manner
- 21 described by Section 130.0828, Education Code, as added by this
- 22 Act, so that the composition of the board of trustees complies with
- 23 applicable law.
- (e) Section 311.032(a), Government Code, applies to this
- 25 Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
