- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 411.1403 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 411.1403. ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD
- 8 INFORMATION: RAILROAD COMMISSION OF TEXAS. (a) The Railroad
- 9 Commission of Texas is entitled to obtain from the department, the
- 10 Federal Bureau of Investigation Criminal Justice Information
- 11 Services Division, or another law enforcement agency criminal
- 12 history record information maintained by the department, division,
- 13 or agency that relates to a person who is:
- 14 (1) an applicant for employment with, or who is or has
- 15 been employed by, the commission; or
- 16 (2) a consultant, contract employee, independent
- 17 contractor, intern, or volunteer for the commission or an applicant
- 18 to serve in one of those positions.
- 19 <u>(b) Criminal history record information obtained by the</u>
- 20 Railroad Commission of Texas under Subsection (a) may be used only
- 21 to evaluate an applicant for employment with, or a current or former
- 22 employee of, the commission.
- 23 (c) The Railroad Commission of Texas may not release or
- 24 disclose information obtained under Subsection (a) except on court

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- 1 order or with the consent of the person who is the subject of the
- 2 <u>criminal history record information.</u>
- 3 (d) After the expiration of any probationary term of the
- 4 person's employment or not later than the 180th day after the date
- 5 of receipt of the information, whichever is later, the Railroad
- 6 Commission of Texas shall destroy all criminal history record
- 7 information obtained under Subsection (a).
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
