- SECTION 2. Section 504.007, Transportation Code, is amended

- 16 assessor-collector determines that the owner of a registered motor
- 17 vehicle did not receive license plates that were issued to the owner
- 18 by mail.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
