The 10 subpoena may require a person to give a deposition, produce 11 documents, or both. 12 (b) If a person disobeys a subpoena or if a person appearing 13 14 in a deposition in connection with the investigation refuses to testify, the commissioner may petition a district court in Travis 15 16 County to issue an order requiring the person to obey the subpoena, testify, or produce documents relating to the matter. The court 17 shall promptly set an application to enforce a subpoena issued 18 under Subsection (a) for hearing and shall cause notice of the 19 application and the hearing to be served on the person to whom the 20 subpoena is directed. 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 22 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
