- 5 SECTION 1. Section 31.035, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a [A] county
- 9 elections administrator may not be a candidate for a public office
- 10 or an office of a political party, hold a public office, or hold an
- 11 office of or position in a political party. At the time an
- 12 administrator becomes a candidate or accepts an office or position
- 13 in violation of this subsection, the administrator vacates the
- 14 position of administrator.
- 15 (d) For a county with a population of less than 1,000, the
- 16 county elections administrator may hold or be a candidate for a
- 17 public office if:
- 18 <u>(1) no part of the jurisdiction of the office is</u>
- 19 <u>located in the county where the person serves as the elections</u>
- 20 <u>administrator; and</u>
- 21 (2) any election for that office is a nonpartisan
- 22 election.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
