5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 547.001, Transportation Code, is amended
7	by adding Subdivisions (2-b) and (6-a) to read as follows:
8	(2-b) "Highway maintenance vehicle" means a highway or
9	traffic maintenance vehicle designated by the Texas Department of
10	Transportation. The term includes equipment for:
11	(A) road maintenance, including:
12	(i) equipment for snow removal, line
13	striping, skid resistance testing, sweeping, and spraying;
14	(ii) aerial platform lift machines; and
15	(iii) road profiler machines; and
16	(B) off-road use, including motor graders, road
17	rollers, excavators, pneumatic tire equipment, movers, and
18	tractors.
19	(6-a) "Service vehicle" means a highway or traffic
20	maintenance vehicle that:
21	(A) is owned and operated on a highway by or for a
22	governmental agency and performs a function requiring the use of a
23	lamp or illuminating device in accordance with the standards and
24	specifications adopted under Section 547.105; or

(B) has a public service function, including 1 public utility vehicles, tow trucks, and any vehicle designated as 2 a service vehicle by the Texas Department of Transportation or as an 3 escort flag vehicle under Section 623.099. 4 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 547.105, Transportation 5 6 Code, is amended to read as follows: MAINTENANCE AND SERVICE VEHICLE [EQUIPMENT] 7 Sec. 547.105. LIGHTING STANDARDS. 8 SECTION 3. Sections 547.105(a) and (b), Transportation 9 Code, are amended to read as follows: 10 The Texas Department of Transportation shall adopt 11 (a) standards and specifications that: 12 apply to lamps on highway maintenance and service 13 (1)14 vehicles [equipment, including snow-removal equipment]; and correlate with and conform as closely as possible 15 (2) 16 standards and specifications approved by the American to 17 Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials. The Texas Department of Transportation may 18 (b) adopt standards and specifications for lighting that permit the use of 19 flashing lights for identification purposes on highway maintenance 20 21 and service vehicles [equipment, including snow-removal 22 equipment]. SECTION 4. Section 547.305(e), Transportation Code, 23 is 24 amended to read as follows: 25 (e) A person may not operate <u>a</u> highway maintenance or 26 service vehicle [equipment, including snow-removal equipment,]

that is not equipped with lamps or that does not display lighted

lamps as required by the standards and specifications adopted by
the Texas Department of Transportation.

3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
