4	SECTION 1. Section 755.001(17), Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(17) "Portable [power] boiler" means a boiler
7	primarily intended for use at a temporary location.
8	SECTION 2. Section 755.022(a), Health and Safety Code, is
9	amended to read as follows:
10	(a) This chapter does not apply to:
11	(1) boilers owned or operated by the federal
12	government;
13	(2) pressure vessels or process steam generators,
14	other than steam collection or liberation drums of process steam
15	generators;
16	(3) manually fired miniature boilers that:
17	(A) are constructed or maintained for
18	locomotives, boats, tractors, or stationary engines only as a hobby
19	for exhibition, recreation, education, or historical purposes and
20	not for commercial use;
21	(B) have an inside diameter of 12 inches or less
22	or a grate area of two square feet or less; and
23	(C) are equipped with a safety valve of adequate
24	size, a water level indicator, and a pressure gauge;

boilers that are designed for operation only at 1 (4) atmospheric pressure and that are equipped with two independent 2 3 means to prevent the buildup of pressure; [or]

(5) steam cookers; or

(6) espresso machines.

6 SECTION 3. Section 755.025(e), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 (e) The commission by rule shall establish the subsequent intervals and manner of inspection for a [A] portable [power] 9 10 boiler [must be inspected externally each time the boiler is moved to a new location and must receive an internal inspection at least 11 annually]. 12

SECTION 4. Chapter 755, Health and Safety Code, is amended 13 14 by adding Subchapter E to read as follows:

15 SUBCHAPTER E. REGULATION OF BOILERS AND FUEL GAS SYSTEMS

Sec. 755.071. RESTRICTION ON REGULATION. Notwithstanding 16 17 any other law, a state agency or political subdivision may not restrict the use or installation of a specific fuel gas pipe product 18 that is approved for use and installation by the International Fuel 19 Gas Code. 20

Sec. 755.072. CONFLICT OF LAW. To the extent of a conflict between this subchapter and another law, this subchapter controls.

23 SECTION 5. As soon as practicable after the effective date 24 of this Act, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules necessary to implement the changes in law made by 25 26 this Act.

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
