17	postsecondary credential, certificate, or degree;
18	(2) has seven years of full-time wage-earning
19	experience within the preceding 10 years in an approved occupation
20	for which instruction is offered;
21	(3) holds with respect to that occupation a current
22	license, certificate, or registration, as applicable, issued by a
23	nationally recognized accrediting agency based on a recognized test
24	or measurement; and

(c) In proposing rules for an educator preparation program 6 7 under this section, the board shall ensure that the program 8 requires at least 80 hours of classroom instruction in: 9 (1) a specific pedagogy; 10 (2) creating lesson plans; 11 (3) creating student assessment instruments; 12 (4) classroom management; and (5) relevant federal and state education laws. 13 Sec. 21.0491. PROBATIONARY AND STANDARD 14 TRADE AND 15 INDUSTRIAL WORKFORCE TRAINING CERTIFICATES. (a) To provide a continuing additional source of teachers to provide workforce 16 training, the board shall establish a probationary trade and 17 industrial workforce training certificate and a standard trade and 18 19 industrial workforce training certificate that may be obtained through an abbreviated educator preparation program under Section 20 21.0442. 21 22 (b) To be eligible for a probationary certificate under this section, a person must: 23

- 10 (3) establishing standards to govern the approval and
- 11 renewal of approval of educator preparation programs for
- 12 certification in trade and industrial workforce training.
- 13 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect only if a specific
- 14 appropriation for the implementation of the Act is provided in a
- 15 general appropriations act of the 85th Legislature.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
