Section 6311), and its subsequent 10 11 amendments], to provide notice to a parent or guardian regarding a 12 teacher who does not meet certification requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher is assigned [is not 13 14 highly qualified], provided the school provides notice as required by that Act. 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19

Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
