- 9 require, in addition to examination requirements as set out in
- 10 Subsections (b), (c), and (d) [of this section]:
- 11 (1) an examination for technical competence that is
- 12 validated by a recognized educational testing organization or
- 13 similar organization; or
- 14 (2) attendance at approved academic, trade,
- 15 professional, or commission-sponsored seminars or $[\tau]$ other
- 16 continuing education programs[, and periodic reexaminations].
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 113.087, Natural Resources Code, as
- 18 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for an original
- 19 or renewal license submitted on or after the effective date of this
- 20 Act. An application submitted before that date is governed by the
- 21 law in effect on the date the application was submitted, and the
- 22 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
