- 2 (a) The commission or its designee shall send notice of a 3 proposed final action on a federal operating permit by first-class 4 mail or electronic communication to the applicant and all persons 5 who comment during the public comment period or at the public 6 hearing. The notice shall include a response to any comment 7 submitted during the public comment period and shall identify any 8 change in the conditions of the draft permit and the reasons for the 9 change.
