Sections 552.221(b-1) and (b-2), Government 5 6 Code, are amended to read as follows: 7 In addition to the methods of production described by 8 Subsection (b), an officer for public information for governmental body [political subdivision of this state] complies 9 10 with Subsection (a) by referring a requestor to an exact Internet location or uniform resource locator (URL) address on a website 11 12 maintained by the governmental body [political subdivision] and 13 accessible to the public if the requested information identifiable and readily available on that website. If the person 14 15 requesting the information prefers a manner other than access through the URL, the governmental body [political subdivision] must 16 17 supply the information in the manner required by Subsection (b). (b-2) If 18 an officer for public information for а governmental body [political subdivision] provides by e-mail an 19 Internet location or uniform resource locator (URL) address as 20 permitted by Subsection (b-1), the e-mail must contain a statement 21 22 in a conspicuous font clearly indicating that the requestor may

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nonetheless access the requested information by inspection or

duplication or by receipt through United States mail, as provided

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- 1 by Subsection (b).
- 2 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 4 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
- 5 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 6 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 7 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 8 effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
