- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 140.0045 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 140.0045. ITEMIZATION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC NOTICE
- 8 EXPENDITURES REQUIRED IN CERTAIN POLITICAL SUBDIVISION BUDGETS.
- 9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the proposed budget of a
- 10 political subdivision must include a line item indicating
- 11 expenditures for notices required by law to be published in a
- 12 newspaper by the political subdivision or a representative of the
- 13 political subdivision that allows as clear a comparison as
- 14 practicable between those expenditures in the proposed budget and
- 15 actual expenditures for the same purpose in the preceding year.
- 16 (b) This section does not apply to a junior college
- 17 district.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 140.0045, Local
- 19 Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a proposed
- 20 budget for a fiscal year beginning on or after January 1, 2018.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

1 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
