# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 28.025(b-2), Education Code, as amended 6 by Chapters 211 (H.B. 5) and 214 (H.B. 2201), Acts of the 83rd 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is reenacted and amended to 8 read as follows:

9 (b-2) In adopting rules under Subsection (b-1), the State 10 Board of Education shall:

(1) provide for a student to comply with 11 the 12 curriculum requirements for an advanced English course under 13 Subsection (b-1)(1) [taken after successful completion of English I, English II, and English III], for an advanced mathematics course 14 15 under Subsection (b-1)(2) [taken after the successful completion of Algebra I and geometry], and for any advanced science course under 16 Subsection (b-1)(3) by successfully completing a course in the 17 appropriate content area that has been approved as an advanced 18 course by board rule or that is offered as an advanced course for 19 credit without board approval as provided by Section 28.002(g-1); 20 21 and

22 (2) allow <u>a student to comply with the curriculum</u> 23 <u>requirements for</u> the third and fourth <u>mathematics</u> credits <u>under</u> 24 <u>Subsection (b-1)(2)</u> or the third and fourth <u>science</u> credits <u>under</u>

Subsection (b-1)(3) by successfully completing an advanced career and technical course designated by the State Board of Education as containing substantively similar and rigorous academic content.

4 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 5 school year.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
