21	(1) a fee for the filing of a guardianship proceeding;

(a) In this 5 6 section: 7 (1) "Eligible proposed ward" or "eligible ward" means an individual listed in Section 615.003, Government Code. 8 (2) "Line of duty" and "personal injury" have the 9 meanings assigned by Section 615.021(e), Government Code. 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the clerk of a court may 11 not charge, or collect from, the estate of an eligible proposed ward 12 13 or eligible ward any of the following fees if the court finds the proposed ward or ward became incapacitated as a result of a personal 14 injury sustained in the line of duty in the individual's position as 15 16 described by Section 615.003, Government Code: 17 (1) a fee for the filing of a guardianship proceeding; 18 and (2) a fee for any service rendered by the court 19 20 regarding the administration of the guardianship. (c) The clerk of a county court is not required to refund a 21 fee exempt under this section that is paid before September 1, 2017. 22 This subsection expires September 1, 2019. 23 24 SECTION 2.
