- 5 SECTION 1. Section 403.005, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 403.005. POWERS AND DUTIES. (a) The Texas Low-Level
- 8 Radioactive Waste Disposal Compact Commission and the members of
- 9 the commission have the powers and duties prescribed by the
- 10 compact. The members of the commission are responsible for
- 11 administering the provisions of the compact.
- 12 (b) The commission may conduct other activities not
- 13 described by the federal law governing the commission or the
- 14 compact, as long as those activities are consistent with the
- 15 policies and procedures of this state.
- SECTION 2. Section 403.0051, Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 403.0051. COMMISSION AS INDEPENDENT ENTITY; FUNDING.
- 19 (a) The commission is an independent entity <u>established by federal</u>
- 20 law and governed by the compact and is not an agency of this state or
- 21 a program, department, or other division of, or administratively
- 22 attached to, an agency of this state [the Texas Commission on
- 23 Environmental Quality].
- 24 (b) The legislature may appropriate money to the

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- 1 commission. Money for the commission may not be appropriated as
- 2 part of an appropriation for the Texas Commission on Environmental
- 3 Quality.
- 4 <u>(c) The comptroller may:</u>
- 5 (1) assign the commission an agency code; and
- 6 (2) from funds appropriated to the commission, provide
- 7 for the reimbursement of a commission member or employee or a person
- 8 who contracts with the commission for purchases approved by the
- 9 commission, including state and local sales tax.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
