5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 29.012, Education Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
8	(c-1) The commissioner by rule shall require each school
9	district and open-enrollment charter school to include in the
10	district's or school's Public Education Information Management
11	System (PEIMS) report the number of children with disabilities
12	residing in a residential facility who:
13	(1) are required to be tracked by the Residential
14	Facility Monitoring (RFM) System; and
15	(2) receive educational services from the district or
16	school.
17	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
18	school year.
19	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect only if a specific
20	appropriation for the implementation of the Act is provided in a
21	general appropriations act of the 85th Legislature.
22	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
