A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to regulation of steroid use by students participating in
- 3 athletic competitions sponsored or sanctioned by the University
- 4 Interscholastic League.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 33.091, Education Code,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 33.091. <u>REGULATION [PREVENTION]</u> OF [<u>ILLEGAL</u>] STEROID
- 9 USE; RANDOM TESTING.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 33.091, Education Code, is amended by
- 11 amending Subsection (h) and adding Subsections (i), (j), (k), and
- 12 (1) to read as follows:
- (h) Except as provided by Subsection (i), Subsection (b)(1)
- 14 does not apply to the use by a student of a steroid that is
- 15 dispensed, prescribed, delivered, and administered by a medical
- 16 practitioner for a valid medical purpose and in the course of
- 17 professional practice, and a student is not subject to a period of
- 18 ineligibility under Subsection (d)(6) on the basis of that steroid
- 19 use. A student to whom this subsection applies must, at a time
- 20 determined by the league, notify the league of the steroid use using
- 21 <u>a form approved by the league. The form must include consent to:</u>
- (1) the release to the league of the student's
- 23 health-related information relevant to the student's steroid use;
- 24 and

- 1 (2) communication between the league and the student's
- 2 health care practitioners regarding the student's steroid use.
- 3 (i) The league may declare a student ineligible for
- 4 competition on the basis of steroid use described by Subsection (h)
- 5 if the league determines that the safety of competing students or
- 6 the fairness of a particular competition has been or will be
- 7 substantially affected by the student's steroid use.
- 8 <u>(j) The league may adopt rules regarding the use of steroids</u>
- 9 by students participating in an athletic competition sponsored or
- 10 sanctioned by the league, including rules providing for sanctions
- 11 and loss of eligibility for violation of league rules. The rules
- 12 must provide a process for the league to determine that a student is
- 13 in violation of this section or league rules.
- 14 <u>(k) A league hearing regarding a student's use of steroids</u>
- 15 shall be conducted in a closed session.
- 16 (1) The following information is confidential and not
- 17 <u>subject to disclosure under Chapter 552</u>, Government Code:
- 18 (1) health-related information obtained by the league
- 19 under Subsection (h); and
- 20 (2) information in a record arising from the league's
- 21 evaluation of a student's steroid use described by Subsection (h)
- 22 that could identify the student.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 the vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
