

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of Lakewood Improvement District of Harris
3 County; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to
4 impose assessments, fees, or taxes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws
7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 3951 to read as follows:

8 CHAPTER 3951. LAKEWOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF HARRIS COUNTY

9 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

10 Sec. 3951.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:

11 (1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.

12 (2) "City" means the City of Houston.

13 (3) "County" means Harris County.

14 (4) "Director" means a board member.

15 (5) "District" means the Lakewood Improvement
16 District of Harris County.

17 Sec. 3951.002. NATURE OF DISTRICT. The district is a
18 special district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
19 Constitution.

20 Sec. 3951.003. PURPOSE; DECLARATION OF INTENT. (a) The
21 creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of
22 Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,
23 Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this
24 chapter. By creating the district and in authorizing the city, the

1 county, and other political subdivisions to contract with the
2 district, the legislature has established a program to accomplish
3 the public purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas
4 Constitution.

5 (b) The creation of the district is necessary to promote,
6 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce,
7 transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the arts,
8 entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public
9 welfare in the district, and to accomplish the redevelopment of
10 land in the district.

11 (c) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be
12 interpreted to relieve the city or the county from providing the
13 level of services provided as of the effective date of the Act
14 enacting this chapter to the area in the district. The district is
15 created to supplement and not to supplant city or county services
16 provided in the district.

17 Sec. 3951.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE.

18 (a) The district is created to serve a public use and benefit.

19 (b) All land and other property included in the district
20 will benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by
21 the district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a,
22 Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and
23 other powers granted under this chapter.

24 (c) The creation of the district is in the public interest
25 and is essential to further the public purposes of:

26 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the
27 state;

1 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment; and
2 (3) developing or expanding transportation and
3 commerce.

4 (d) The district will:

5 (1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of
6 residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors,
7 and consumers in the district, and of the public;

8 (2) provide needed funding for the district to
9 preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of
10 the district territory as a community and business center;

11 (3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment
12 of the public by providing pedestrian ways, parking facilities, and
13 conduit facilities and by landscaping and developing certain areas
14 in the district, which are necessary for the restoration,
15 preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty; and

16 (4) provide for road, bridge, and recreational
17 facilities for the district.

18 (e) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at
19 grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street
20 landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and
21 necessary components of a street or road and are considered to be a
22 street or road improvement.

23 (f) The district will not act as the agent or
24 instrumentality of any private interest even though the district
25 will benefit many private interests as well as the public.

26 Sec. 3951.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) The
27 district is initially composed of the territory described by

1 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter.

2 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of
3 the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the
4 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process
5 does not affect the district's:

6 (1) organization, existence, or validity;

7 (2) right to issue any type of bonds for the purposes
8 for which the district is created or to pay the principal of and
9 interest on bonds;

10 (3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or

11 (4) legality or operation.

12 Sec. 3951.006. ELIGIBILITY FOR INCLUSION IN SPECIAL ZONES.

13 All or any part of the area of the district is eligible to be
14 included in:

15 (1) a tax increment reinvestment zone created under
16 Chapter 311, Tax Code;

17 (2) a tax abatement reinvestment zone created under
18 Chapter 312, Tax Code;

19 (3) an enterprise zone created under Chapter 2303,
20 Government Code; or

21 (4) an industrial district created under Chapter 42,
22 Local Government Code.

23 Sec. 3951.007. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT
24 DISTRICTS LAW. Except as otherwise provided by this chapter,
25 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, applies to the district.

26 Sec. 3951.008. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This chapter shall
27 be liberally construed in conformity with the findings and purposes

1 stated in this chapter.

2 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

3 Sec. 3951.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is
4 governed by a board of five voting directors who serve staggered
5 terms of four years, with two or three directors' terms expiring
6 June 1 of each odd-numbered year.

7 (b) The board by resolution may change the number of voting
8 directors on the board if the board determines that the change is in
9 the best interest of the district. The board may not consist of
10 fewer than five or more than nine voting directors.

11 Sec. 3951.052. APPOINTMENT OF VOTING DIRECTORS. The Texas
12 Commission on Environmental Quality shall appoint voting directors
13 from persons recommended by the board.

14 Sec. 3951.053. NONVOTING DIRECTORS. The board may appoint
15 nonvoting directors to serve at the pleasure of the voting
16 directors.

17 Sec. 3951.054. QUORUM. For purposes of determining the
18 requirements for a quorum of the board, the following are not
19 counted:

20 (1) a board position vacant for any reason, including
21 death, resignation, or disqualification;

22 (2) a director who is abstaining from participation in
23 a vote because of a conflict of interest; or

24 (3) a nonvoting director.

25 Sec. 3951.055. COMPENSATION. A director is entitled to
26 receive fees of office and reimbursement for actual expenses as
27 provided by Section 49.060, Water Code. Sections 375.069 and

1 375.070, Local Government Code, do not apply to the board.

2 Sec. 3951.056. INITIAL VOTING DIRECTORS. (a) The initial
3 board consists of:

10 (b) Of the initial directors, the terms of directors
11 appointed for positions one through three expire June 1, 2019, and
12 the terms of directors appointed for positions four and five expire
13 June 1, 2021.

14 (c) Section 3951.052 does not apply to this section.

15 (d) This section expires September 1, 2021.

16 SUBCHAPTER C. POWERS AND DUTIES

17 Sec. 3951.101. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES. The district has
18 the powers and duties necessary to accomplish the purposes for
19 which the district is created.

20 Sec. 3951.102. IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND SERVICES. The
21 district may provide, design, construct, acquire, improve,
22 relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an improvement project or
23 service using any money available to the district, or contract with
24 a governmental or private entity to provide, design, construct,
25 acquire, improve, relocate, operate, maintain, or finance an
26 improvement project or service authorized under this chapter or
27 Chapter 375, Local Government Code.

1 Sec. 3951.103. DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION POWERS. The
2 district, using money available to the district, may exercise the
3 powers given to a development corporation under Chapter 505, Local
4 Government Code, including the power to own, operate, acquire,
5 construct, lease, improve, or maintain a project under that
6 chapter.

7 Sec. 3951.104. NONPROFIT CORPORATION. (a) The board by
8 resolution may authorize the creation of a nonprofit corporation to
9 assist and act for the district in implementing a project or
10 providing a service authorized by this chapter.

11 (b) The nonprofit corporation:

12 (1) has each power of and is considered to be a local
13 government corporation created under Subchapter D, Chapter 431,
14 Transportation Code; and

15 (2) may implement any project and provide any service
16 authorized by this chapter.

17 (c) The board shall appoint the board of directors of the
18 nonprofit corporation. The board of directors of the nonprofit
19 corporation shall serve in the same manner as the board of directors
20 of a local government corporation created under Subchapter D,
21 Chapter 431, Transportation Code, except that a board member is not
22 required to reside in the district.

23 Sec. 3951.105. AGREEMENTS; GRANTS. (a) As provided by
24 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, the district may make an
25 agreement with or accept a gift, grant, or loan from any person.

26 (b) The implementation of a project is a governmental
27 function or service for the purposes of Chapter 791, Government

1 Code.

2 Sec. 3951.106. LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES. To protect the
3 public interest, the district may contract with a qualified party,
4 including the county or the city, to provide law enforcement
5 services in the district for a fee.

6 Sec. 3951.107. MEMBERSHIP IN CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS. The
7 district may join and pay dues to a charitable or nonprofit
8 organization that performs a service or provides an activity
9 consistent with the furtherance of a district purpose.

10 Sec. 3951.108. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. (a) The district may
11 engage in activities that accomplish the economic development
12 purposes of the district.

13 (b) The district may establish and provide for the
14 administration of one or more programs to promote state or local
15 economic development and to stimulate business and commercial
16 activity in the district, including programs to:

17 (1) make loans and grants of public money; and

18 (2) provide district personnel and services.

19 (c) The district may create economic development programs
20 and exercise the economic development powers provided to
21 municipalities by:

22 (1) Chapter 380, Local Government Code; and

23 (2) Subchapter A, Chapter 1509, Government Code.

24 Sec. 3951.109. PARKING FACILITIES. (a) The district may
25 acquire, lease as lessor or lessee, construct, develop, own,
26 operate, and maintain parking facilities or a system of parking
27 facilities, including lots, garages, parking terminals, or other

1 structures or accommodations for parking motor vehicles off the
2 streets and related appurtenances.

3 (b) The district's parking facilities serve the public
4 purposes of the district and are owned, used, and held for a public
5 purpose even if leased or operated by a private entity for a term of
6 years.

7 (c) The district's parking facilities are parts of and
8 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street
9 or road improvement.

10 (d) The development and operation of the district's parking
11 facilities may be considered an economic development program.

12 Sec. 3951.110. ANNEXATION AND EXCLUSION OF LAND. (a) The
13 district may annex land as provided by Subchapter J, Chapter 49,
14 Water Code.

15 (b) The district may exclude land as provided by Subchapter
16 J, Chapter 49, Water Code. Section 375.044(b), Local Government
17 Code, does not apply to the district.

18 Sec. 3951.111. NAVIGATION DISTRICT POWERS. (a) The
19 district has the powers provided by the general law of this state
20 applicable to navigation districts created under Section 59,
21 Article XVI, Texas Constitution, including Chapters 60 and 62,
22 Water Code.

23 (b) The district may purchase, construct, acquire, own,
24 operate, maintain, improve, or extend, inside and outside the
25 district, a canal, waterway, bulkhead, dock, or other improvement
26 or facility necessary or convenient to accomplish the navigation
27 purposes of the district.

1 Sec. 3951.112. ROAD DISTRICT POWERS. The district has the
2 powers provided by the general laws relating to road districts and
3 road utility districts created under Section 52(b), Article III,
4 Texas Constitution, including Chapters 257 and 441, Transportation
5 Code.

6 Sec. 3951.113. ROAD STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS. (a) A
7 road project must meet all applicable construction standards,
8 zoning and subdivision requirements, and regulations of each
9 municipality in whose corporate limits or extraterritorial
10 jurisdiction the road project is located.

11 (b) If a road project is not located in the corporate limits
12 or extraterritorial jurisdiction of a municipality, the road
13 project must meet all applicable construction standards,
14 subdivision requirements, and regulations of each county in which
15 the road project is located.

16 (c) If the state will maintain and operate the road, the
17 Texas Transportation Commission must approve the plans and
18 specifications of the road project.

19 Sec. 3951.114. PROPERTY OF CERTAIN UTILITIES EXEMPT FROM
20 ASSESSMENTS AND FEES. The district may not impose an assessment,
21 impact fee, or standby fee on the property, including the
22 equipment, rights-of-way, easements, facilities, or improvements,
23 of:

24 (1) an electric utility or a power generation company
25 as defined by Section 31.002, Utilities Code;

26 (2) a gas utility, as defined by Section 101.003 or
27 121.001, Utilities Code, or a person who owns pipelines used for the

1 transportation or sale of oil or gas or a product or constituent of
2 oil or gas;

3 (3) a person who owns pipelines used for the
4 transportation or sale of carbon dioxide;

5 (4) a telecommunications provider as defined by
6 Section 51.002, Utilities Code; or

7 (5) a cable service provider or video service provider
8 as defined by Section 66.002, Utilities Code.

9 Sec. 3951.115. USE OF ELECTRICAL OR OPTICAL LINES.

10 (a) The district may impose an assessment to pay the cost of:

11 (1) burying or removing electrical power lines,
12 telephone lines, cable or fiber-optic lines, or any other type of
13 electrical or optical line; and

14 (2) removing poles and any elevated lines using the
15 poles.

16 (b) The district may finance, acquire, construct, improve,
17 operate, maintain, or charge fees for the use of the district
18 conduits for another person's:

19 (1) telecommunications network; or

20 (2) fiber-optic cable.

21 (c) Consistent with Title 2, Utilities Code, the district
22 may finance, construct, or maintain conduits for:

23 (1) electronic transmission and distribution lines
24 and supporting facilities; or

25 (2) other types of transmission and distribution lines
26 and supporting facilities.

27 (d) The district may not require a person to use a district

1 conduit.

2 Sec. 3951.116. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
3 not exercise the power of eminent domain.

4 SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS; ASSESSMENTS

5 Sec. 3951.151. DISBURSEMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF MONEY. The
6 board by resolution shall establish the number of directors'
7 signatures and the procedure required for a disbursement or
8 transfer of district money.

9 Sec. 3951.152. MONEY USED FOR IMPROVEMENTS OR SERVICES.
10 The district may acquire, construct, finance, operate, or maintain
11 any improvement or service authorized under this chapter or Chapter
12 375, Local Government Code, using any money available to the
13 district.

14 Sec. 3951.153. PETITION REQUIRED FOR FINANCING SERVICES AND
15 IMPROVEMENTS WITH ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board may not finance a
16 service or improvement project with assessments under this chapter
17 unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement
18 has been filed with the board.

19 (b) A petition filed under Subsection (a) must be signed by
20 the owners of a majority of the assessed value of real property in
21 the district subject to assessment according to the most recent
22 certified tax appraisal roll for the county.

23 Sec. 3951.154. ASSESSMENTS; LIENS FOR ASSESSMENTS.

24 (a) The board by resolution may impose and collect an assessment
25 for any purpose authorized by this chapter in all or any part of the
26 district.

27 (b) An assessment, a reassessment, or an assessment

1 resulting from an addition to or correction of the assessment roll
2 by the district, penalties and interest on an assessment or
3 reassessment, an expense of collection, and reasonable attorney's
4 fees incurred by the district:

5 (1) are a first and prior lien against the property
6 assessed;

7 (2) are superior to any other lien or claim other than
8 a lien or claim for county, school district, or municipal ad valorem
9 taxes; and

10 (3) are the personal liability of and a charge against
11 the owners of the property even if the owners are not named in the
12 assessment proceedings.

13 (c) The lien is effective from the date of the board's
14 resolution imposing the assessment until the date the assessment is
15 paid. The board may enforce the lien in the same manner that the
16 board may enforce an ad valorem tax lien against real property.

17 (d) The board may make a correction to or deletion from the
18 assessment roll that does not increase the amount of assessment of
19 any parcel of land without providing notice and holding a hearing in
20 the manner required for additional assessments.

21 Sec. 3951.155. TAX AND ASSESSMENT ABATEMENTS. The district
22 may designate reinvestment zones and may grant abatements of a tax
23 or assessment on property in the zones.

24 Sec. 3951.156. RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY NOT EXEMPT. Section
25 375.161, Local Government Code, does not apply to the district.

26 Sec. 3951.157. COMPETITIVE BIDDING. Subchapter I, Chapter
27 49, Water Code, applies to the district. Sections 375.221 and

1 375.223, Local Government Code, do not apply to the district.

2 SUBCHAPTER E. TAXES AND BONDS

3 Sec. 3951.201. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES AND BONDS.

4 (a) The district may issue, without an election, bonds, notes, and
5 other obligations secured by:

6 (1) revenue other than ad valorem taxes; or

7 (2) contract payments described by Section 3951.203.

8 (b) The district must hold an election in the manner
9 provided by Subchapter L, Chapter 375, Local Government Code, to
10 obtain voter approval before the district may impose an ad valorem
11 tax or issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes.

12 (c) Section 375.243, Local Government Code, does not apply
13 to the district.

14 (d) All or any part of any facilities or improvements that
15 may be acquired by a district by the issuance of its bonds may be
16 submitted as a single proposition or as several propositions to be
17 voted on at the election.

18 Sec. 3951.202. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
19 authorized by a majority of the district voters voting at an
20 election held in accordance with Section 3951.201, the district may
21 impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in the
22 district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code, for any
23 district purpose, including to:

24 (1) maintain and operate the district;

25 (2) construct or acquire improvements; or

26 (3) provide a service.

27 (b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not

1 exceed the rate approved at the election.

2 (c) Section 49.107(h), Water Code, does not apply to the
3 district.

4 Sec. 3951.203. CONTRACT TAXES. (a) In accordance with
5 Section 49.108, Water Code, the district may impose a tax other than
6 an operation and maintenance tax and use the revenue derived from
7 the tax to make payments under a contract after the provisions of
8 the contract have been approved by a majority of the district voters
9 voting at an election held for that purpose.

10 (b) A contract approved by the district voters may contain a
11 provision stating that the contract may be modified or amended by
12 the board without further voter approval.

13 Sec. 3951.204. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE BONDS
14 AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may borrow money on terms
15 determined by the board. Section 375.205, Local Government Code,
16 does not apply to a loan, line of credit, or other borrowing from a
17 bank or financial institution secured by revenue other than ad
18 valorem taxes.

19 (b) The district may issue bonds, notes, or other
20 obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes,
21 assessments, impact fees, revenue, contract payments, grants, or
22 other district money, or any combination of those sources of money,
23 to pay for any authorized district purpose.

24 (c) The limitation on the outstanding principal amount of
25 bonds, notes, and other obligations provided by Section 49.4645,
26 Water Code, does not apply to the district.

27 Sec. 3951.205. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district

1 issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the
2 board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing
3 direct annual ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount,
4 for each year that all or part of the bonds are outstanding as
5 required and in the manner provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602,
6 Water Code.

7 Sec. 3951.206. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of
8 issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations
9 issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad
10 valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the
11 real property in the district.

12 SUBCHAPTER F. SALES AND USE TAX

13 Sec. 3951.251. MEANINGS OF WORDS AND PHRASES. A word or
14 phrase used in this subchapter that is defined by Chapter 151 or
15 321, Tax Code, has the meaning assigned by Chapter 151 or 321, Tax
16 Code.

17 Sec. 3951.252. APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN TAX CODE
18 PROVISIONS. (a) The provisions of Subchapters C, D, E, and F,
19 Chapter 323, Tax Code, relating to county sales and use taxes apply
20 to the application, collection, and administration of a sales and
21 use tax imposed under this subchapter to the extent consistent with
22 this chapter, as if references in Chapter 323, Tax Code, to a county
23 referred to the district and references to a commissioners court
24 referred to the board.

25 (b) Sections 323.401-323.404 and 323.505, Tax Code, do not
26 apply to a tax imposed under this subchapter.

27 Sec. 3951.253. AUTHORIZATION; ELECTION. (a) The district

1 shall adopt, reduce, or repeal the sales and use tax authorized by
2 this subchapter at an election in which a majority of the voters of
3 the district voting in the election approve the adoption,
4 reduction, or repeal of the tax, as applicable.

5 (b) The board by order shall call an election to adopt,
6 reduce, or repeal a sales and use tax. The election shall be held on
7 the first authorized uniform election date that occurs after the
8 time required by Section 3.005, Election Code.

9 (c) The district shall provide notice of the election and
10 shall hold the election in the manner prescribed by Chapter 54,
11 Water Code, for bond elections for municipal utility districts.

12 (d) The ballots shall be printed to provide for voting for
13 or against the following appropriate proposition:

14 (1) "Adoption of a ___ percent district sales and use
15 tax in the district";

16 (2) "Reduction of the district sales and use tax in the
17 district from ___ percent to ___ percent"; or

18 (3) "Repeal of the district sales and use tax in the
19 district."

20 Sec. 3951.254. EFFECTIVE DATE OF TAX. A tax imposed under
21 this subchapter or the repeal or reduction of a tax under this
22 subchapter takes effect on the first day of the first calendar
23 quarter that occurs after the date the comptroller receives the
24 copy of the resolution as required by Section 323.405(b), Tax Code.

25 Sec. 3951.255. SALES AND USE TAX RATE. (a) On adoption of
26 the tax authorized by this subchapter, there is imposed a tax of two
27 percent, or the maximum rate at which the combined tax rate of all

1 local sales and use taxes in any location in the district does not
2 exceed two percent, on the receipts from the sale at retail of
3 taxable items in the district, and an excise tax on the use,
4 storage, or other consumption in the district of taxable items
5 purchased, leased, or rented from a retailer during the period that
6 the tax is in effect.

7 (b) The rate of the excise tax is the same as the rate of the
8 sales tax portion of the tax and is applied to the sales price of the
9 taxable item.

10 Sec. 3951.256. EXAMINATION AND RECEIPT OF INFORMATION. The
11 district may examine and receive information related to the
12 imposition of a sales and use tax to the same extent as if the
13 district were a municipality.

14 Sec. 3951.257. ALTERNATIVE METHOD OF IMPOSITION.
15 Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter, the
16 district may impose the sales and use tax as provided by Subchapter
17 F, Chapter 383, Local Government Code, instead of as provided by the
18 other provisions of this subchapter.

19 SUBCHAPTER G. DEFINED AREAS

20 Sec. 3951.301. AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH DEFINED AREAS OR
21 DESIGNATED PROPERTY. The district may define areas or designate
22 certain property of the district to pay for improvements,
23 facilities, or services that primarily benefit that area or
24 property and do not generally and directly benefit the district as a
25 whole.

26 Sec. 3951.302. PROCEDURE FOR ELECTION. (a) Before the
27 district may impose an ad valorem tax or issue bonds payable from ad

1 valorem taxes of the defined area or designated property, the board
2 shall hold an election in the defined area or in the designated
3 property only.

4 (b) The board may submit the issues to the voters on the same
5 ballot to be used in another election.

6 Sec. 3951.303. DECLARING RESULT AND ISSUING ORDER. If a
7 majority of the voters voting at the election approve the
8 proposition or propositions, the board shall declare the results
9 and, by order, shall establish the defined area and describe it by
10 metes and bounds or designate the specific property.

11 Sec. 3951.304. TAXES FOR SERVICES, IMPROVEMENTS, AND
12 FACILITIES IN DEFINED AREAS OR DESIGNATED PROPERTY. On voter
13 approval and adoption of the order described by Section 3951.303,
14 the district may apply separately, differently, equitably, and
15 specifically its taxing power and lien authority to the defined
16 area or designated property to provide money to construct,
17 administer, maintain, and operate services, improvements, and
18 facilities that primarily benefit the defined area or designated
19 property.

20 Sec. 3951.305. ISSUANCE OF BONDS FOR DEFINED AREA OR
21 DESIGNATED PROPERTY. After the order under Section 3951.303 is
22 adopted, the district may issue bonds to provide for any land,
23 improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, and appliances for
24 the defined area or designated property.

25 SUBCHAPTER H. DISSOLUTION OF DISTRICT

26 Sec. 3951.351. DISSOLUTION. (a) Except as provided by
27 Subsection (b), the board:

1 (1) may dissolve the district; and

2 (2) shall dissolve the district on receipt of a
3 written petition requesting dissolution signed by the owners of 75
4 percent of the acreage of real property in the district.

5 (b) The board may not dissolve the district until the
6 district's outstanding indebtedness or contractual obligations
7 have been repaid or discharged.

8 (c) After the board dissolves the district, the board shall
9 transfer ownership of all district property and assets to the
10 county.

20 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
21 Government Code.

22 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
23 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
24 Environmental Quality.

25 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
26 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor,
27 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives

1 within the required time.

2 (d) The general law relating to consent by political
3 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation,
4 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those
5 districts has been complied with.

6 (e) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
7 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
8 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
9 fulfilled and accomplished.

10 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
