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The Chair called the following individuals to provide invited and public testimony on the following interim charges (see attached witness list):

- Streamlining Water Permitting: Study and recommend changes that promote streamlining
 of water right permit issuance and the amendment process by the TCEQ for surface
 water, and that promote uniform and streamline permitting by groundwater conservation
 districts for groundwater. Evaluate more transparent process needs and proper valuation
 of water.
- 2) Monitoring: Monitor the implementation of legislation addressed by the Senate Committee on Agriculture, Water & Rural Affairs during the 85th Legislature, Regular Session, including, but not limited to:
 - SB 1511 (prioritization in the regional water plan);
 - SB 1538 (Floodplain Management Account uses);
 - SB 864 (GCD application of state water);
 - HB 2004 (Texas economic development fund for TDA); and
 - HB 3433 (adoption of rules affecting rural communities. Make recommendations for any legislative improvements needed to improve, enhance, or complete implementation including regional water planning, flood planning, and groundwater production.)
