Relating to the provision of state death benefits to peace officers employed by certain private institutions of higher education located in this state.

HB 1545 Clardy

Relating to the acceptance of certain high school courses to satisfy part of the training required to obtain a peace officer license.

HB 1750 Sanford

Relating to exempting certain honorably retired peace officers from continuing education requirements.

HB 1779 Dale

Relating to the authority of the Department of Public Safety to obtain and use criminal history record information for the purpose of performing certain departmental functions.

HB 1780 Dale

Relating to requirements for membership in the reserve officer corps of the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas.

HB 1811 Turner

Relating to hearings conducted by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

HB 2050 Bonnen, Greg

Relating to the confidentiality of certain licensing and employment records submitted to the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement or maintained by a law enforcement agency.
