Relating to the prosecution of the offense of operation of an unmanned aircraft over certain facilities.

Relating to the impoundment of a motor vehicle operated without financial responsibility by a driver who does not have a driver's license; authorizing a fee.

Relating to training regarding interactions with law enforcement during traffic stops.

HB 2306 Guillen | et al.
Relating to the use of auction proceeds from the sale of certain abandoned motor vehicles to reimburse law enforcement agencies for compensation paid to certain property owners.

HB 2317 Metcalf
Relating to access to criminal history record information by an emergency communication district.

HB 2639 Pickett | et al.
Relating to an alert for a missing senior citizen or person with Alzheimer's disease.

HB 2655 Nevárez
Relating to the prosecution of the offense of unlawful transfer of a firearm.

HB 2991 Phillips
Relating to the confidentiality of files related to complaints to and investigations by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

HB 3050 King, Phil
Relating to driver's and learner licenses.

HB 3051 King, Phil
Relating to the categories used to record the race or ethnicity of persons stopped for or convicted of traffic offenses.

HB 3057 Anchia
Relating to the offense of possessing a weapon in a secured area of an airport.

HB 3337 Bonnen, Dennis
Relating to the eligibility of certain persons to teach a driver education course.

HB 3784 Holland | et al.
Relating to persons approved by the Department of Public Safety to offer an online course for the classroom portion of handgun proficiency instruction.
