Relating to prostitution and the trafficking of persons, civil racketeering related to trafficking, the prosecution of and punishment for certain sexual offenses and offenses involving or related to trafficking, reimbursement of certain costs for criminal victims who are children, and the release and reporting of certain information relating to a child; increasing a criminal penalty; creating a criminal offense.

HB 89 King, Phil | et al.
Relating to state contracts with and investments in companies that boycott Israel.

HB 200 Burkett | et al.
Relating to certain prohibited abortions and the treatment and disposition of a human fetus, human fetal tissue, and other tissue resulting from pregnancy; creating a civil cause of action; creating offenses.

HB 582 Dale
Relating to driver's licenses and personal identification certificates issued to refugees or asylees lawfully admitted into the United States.

HB 665 Canales
Relating to the requirement that contractors verify compliance with wage payment laws in contracts with public bodies.

HB 773 Johnson, Eric
Relating to information on projected changes in weather, water availability, and climate variability in strategic plans of certain state agencies.

HB 931 Miller | et al.
Relating to liability of certain electric utilities that allow certain uses of land that the electric utility owns, occupies, or leases.

HB 1048 Minjarez
Relating to the acknowledgment by management of risks identified in state agency information security plans.

HB 1142 Davis, Sarah
Relating to prohibiting governmental contracts with a company doing business with Iran, Sudan, or a foreign terrorist organization.

HB 1290 Roberts | et al.
Relating to the required repeal of a state agency rule before adoption of a new state agency rule.

HB 1615 Alonzo
Relating to a salary career ladder for certain state employees.

HB 1808 Meyer | et al.
Relating to the prosecution and punishment of certain trafficking and sexual offenses.
