Relating to reporting requirements by health care practitioners and certain health care facilities for abortion complications; creating a criminal offense.

Relating to the conscience rights of certain religious organizations and individuals.

HCR 39 Stephenson | et al.
Supporting prayers, including the use of the word "God," at public gatherings, and displays of the Ten Commandments in public educational institutions and other government buildings.

HJR 29 Muñoz, Jr.
Proposing a constitutional amendment requiring the governor's appointments to state boards, commissions, or other governing bodies of state agencies to reflect the gender composition of this state.
