The committee will meet to consider the following:

HCR 26 Keough | et al.
Claiming sovereignty under the Tenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution over all powers not otherwise enumerated and granted to the federal government by the U.S. Constitution.

HCR 29 Bell | et al.
Declaring that presidential executive orders cannot interfere with states' rights.

HCR 30 Springer
Urging Congress to direct the Bureau of Land Management to affirm the provisions of the Red River Boundary Compact and to acknowledge that the vegetation line on the south bank of the Red River forms the boundary between Oklahoma and Texas.

HCR 31 Springer
Urging Congress to encourage the U.S. Department of Agriculture to revise existing policies that promote the waste of water after an irrigated crop has been declared a failure.

HCR 34 Anchia
Urging Congress to propose and submit to the states for ratification an amendment to the U.S. Constitution overturning the Supreme Court's decision in Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission.

HCR 36 Raymond
Urging the U.S. Congress to propose and submit to the states for ratification a federal balanced budget amendment to the U.S. Constitution.

HCR 37 Workman
Calling on Congress to repeal the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

HCR 44 Metcalf | et al.
Urging Congress to pass S.2896, the Care Veterans Deserve Act of 2016.

HCR 52 Flynn | et al.
Urging Congress to reimburse the State of Texas for bearing the financial burden of the federal government's responsibility to secure the Texas-Mexico international border.

HCR 58 Lozano
Urging Congress to provide Texas with Medicaid block grants.

HCR 59 Bailes | et al.
Urging Congress to pass a budget.

HCR 87 Paul | et al.
Urging Congress to direct the Department of Defense to relocate the United States Africa Command to Ellington Field Joint Reserve Base in Houston.
