Relating to a merchant allowing a person suspected of committing or attempting to commit theft to complete a theft education program.

HB 3363 Frank
Relating to the confinement or detention of certain individuals in a county jail or other facility operated by or for the county and to the compensation to the county for the costs of that confinement or detention.

HB 3547 Anchia | et al.
Relating to the required approval of certain hospital visits as a condition of release on parole or to mandatory supervision for certain releasees and to the hospital's liability for damages resulting from those visits.

HB 3603 Anderson
Relating to the payment of restitution by a person released on parole or to mandatory supervision.

HB 3882 Wilson
Relating to the eligibility of a defendant to participate in a veterans treatment court program.

HB 4251 Cook
Relating to the provision of postsecondary education to certain inmates in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
