Relating to the elimination of the portion of the Loan Administration Fee remitted to the comptroller.

Relating to the elimination of the portion of the Retail Charge Agreement Delinquency Fee remitted to the comptroller.

HB 4945 Ashby  
Relating to a study conducted by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas on the feasibility of offering alternative service retirement benefits to Texas A&M Forest Service wildland firefighters that are members of the retirement system.

HB 5015 Geren  
Relating to participation by certain retirement systems in the proportionate retirement program.

HJR 175 Gerdes  
Proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the right to own, hold, and use a mutually agreed upon medium of exchange.
