Relating to required reporting by the Department of Family and Protective Services regarding youth in the managing conservatorship of the department who attempt suicide.

SB 2744 Paxton
Relating to the modernization of cardiovascular screening and prevention under the Texas Heart Attack Prevention Bill.

SB 577 West
Relating to the establishment of the foster child trust account program.

SB 1590 Hancock
Relating to duties of the vital statistics unit of the Department of State Health Services in relation to certain suits affecting the parent-child relationship, including in regard to the electronic transmission of certain information.

SB 1782 Miles
Relating to the maintenance of criminal history record information for group home applicants and employees; creating a criminal offense.
